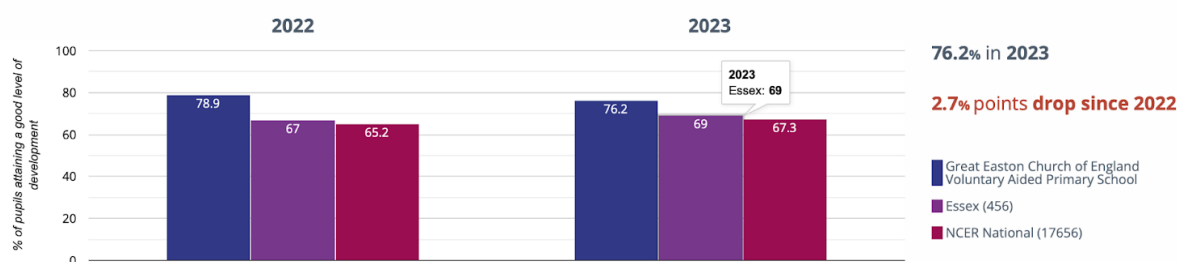

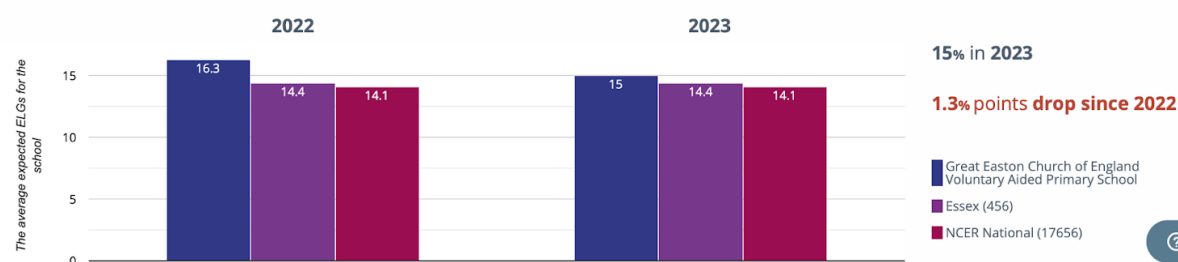

📈 Average number of early learning goals at expected level per child

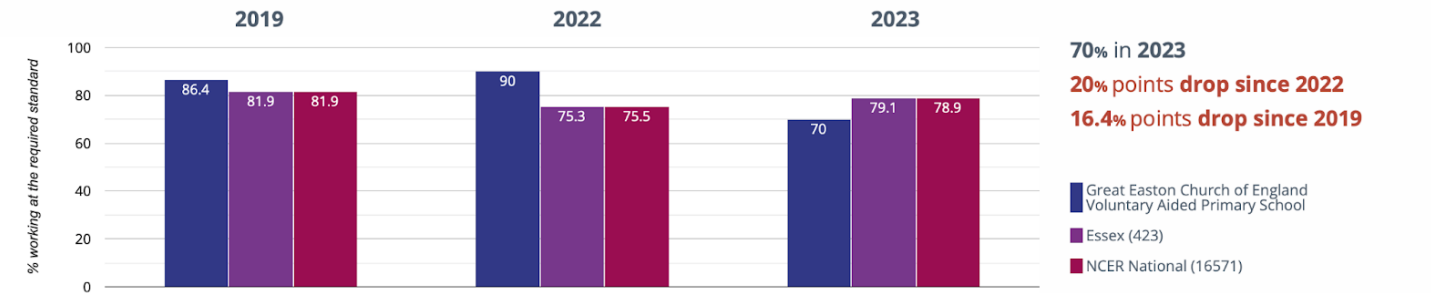

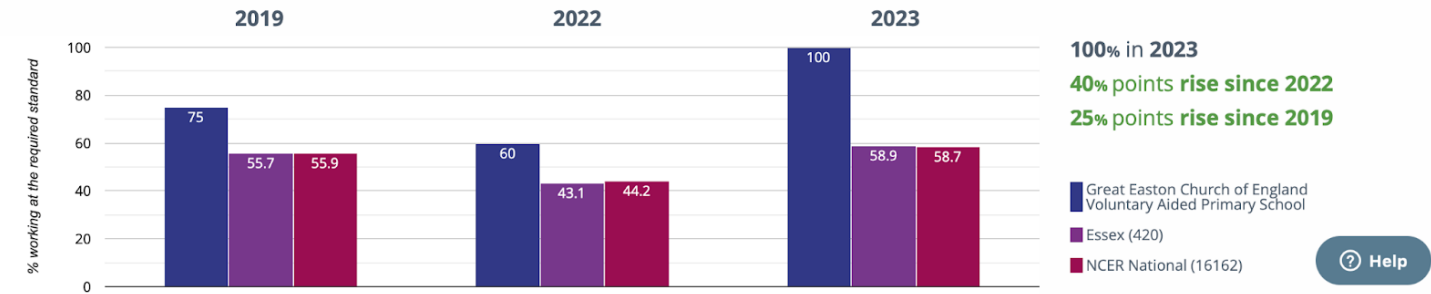

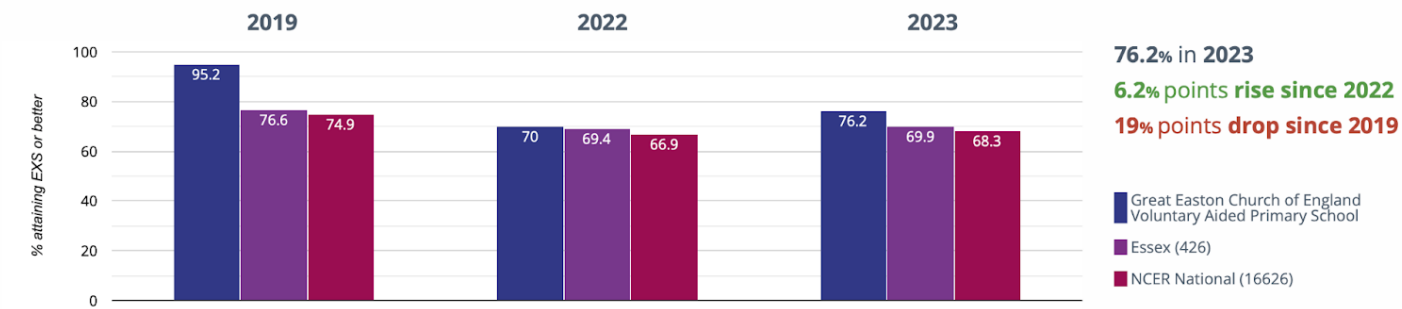

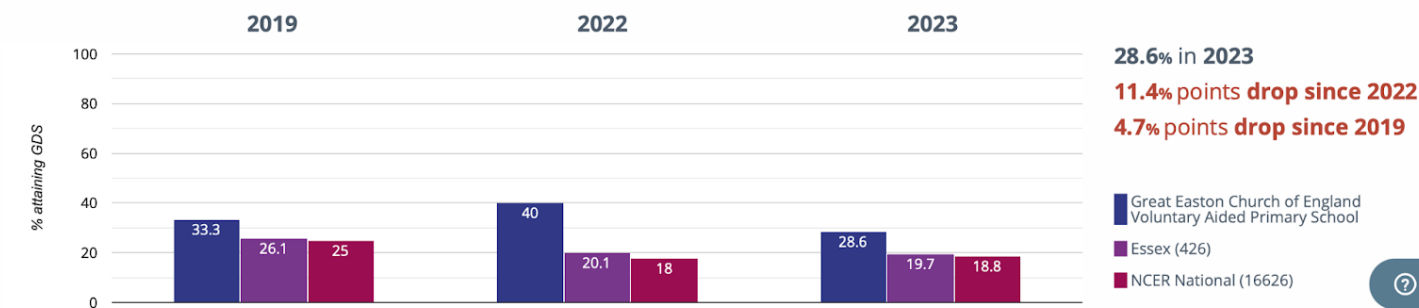

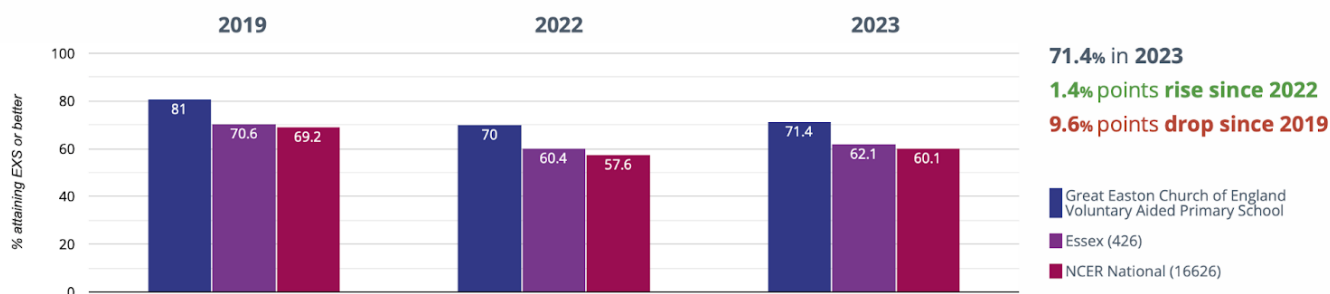

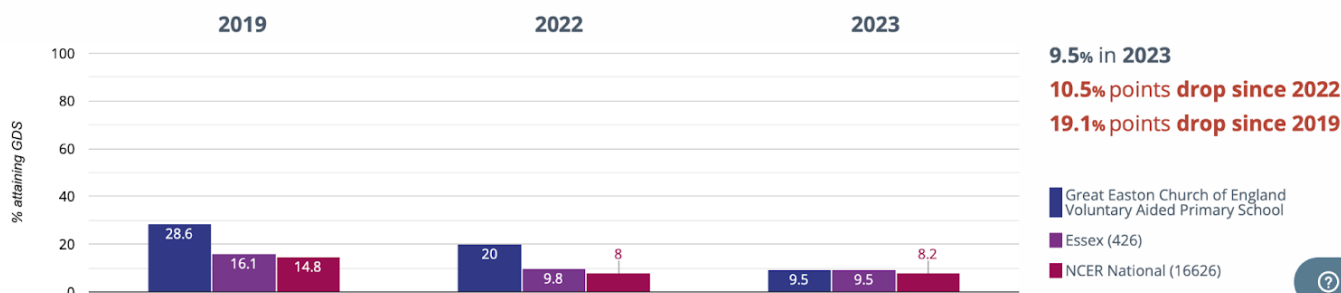
Reading - attaining GDS



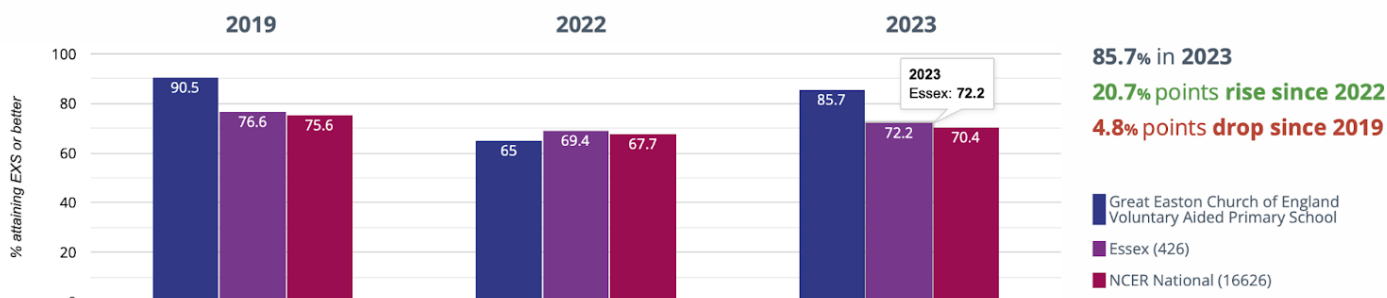
Writing - attaining EXS or better



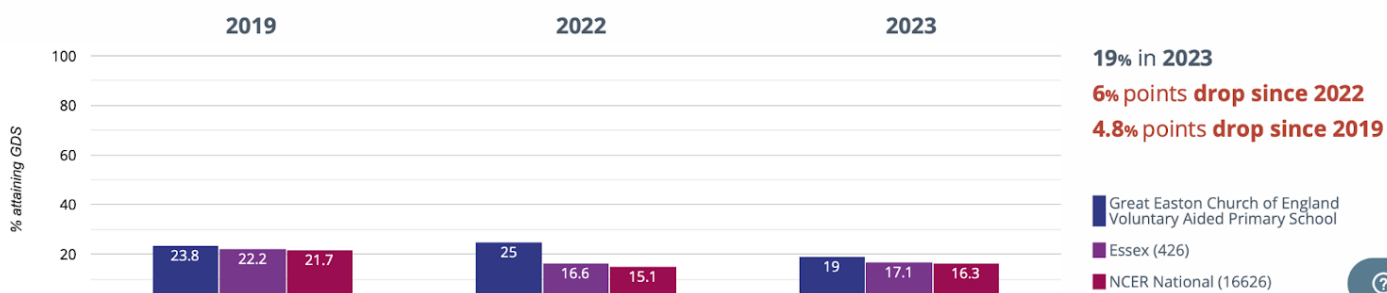
Writing - attaining GDS



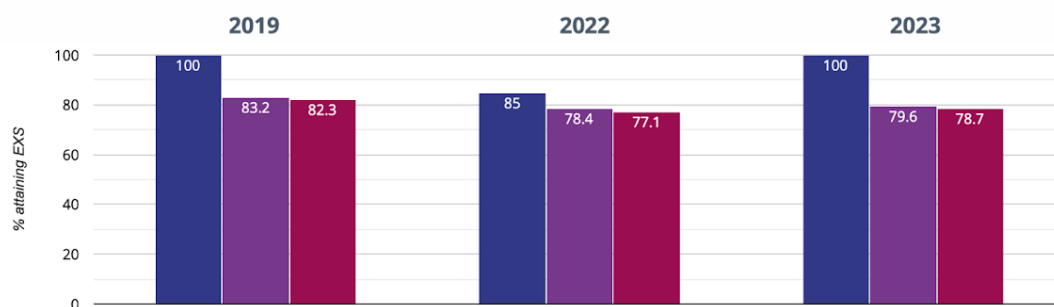
Maths - attaining EXS or better

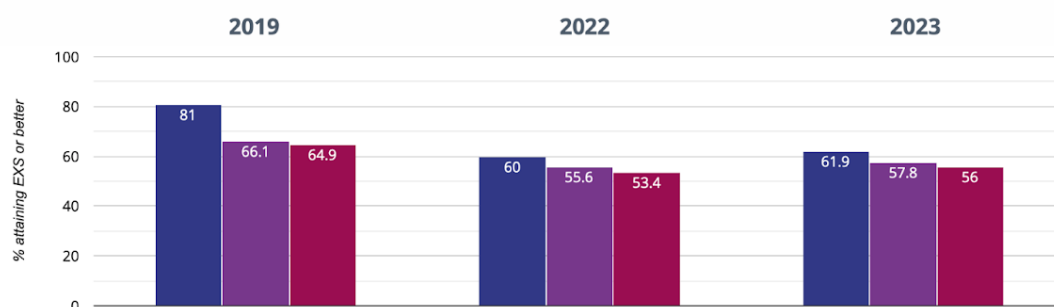

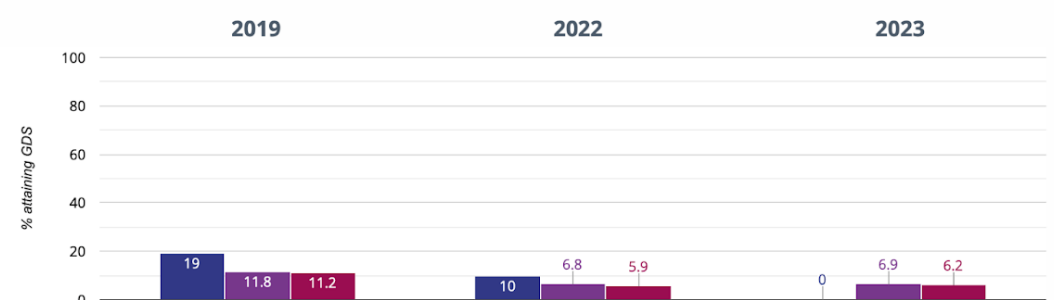

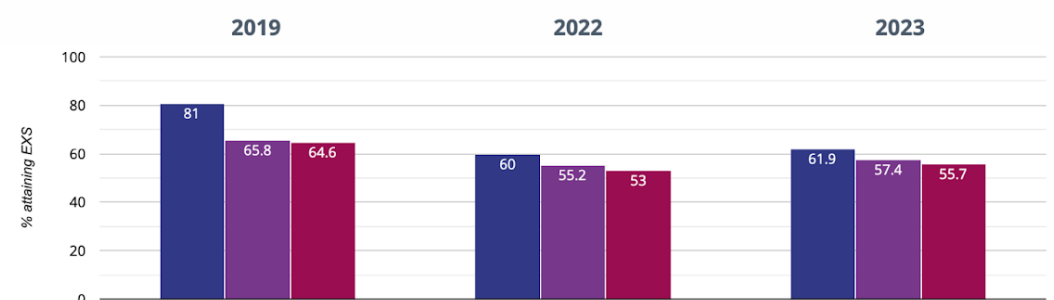

19 children 8 girls and 11 boys

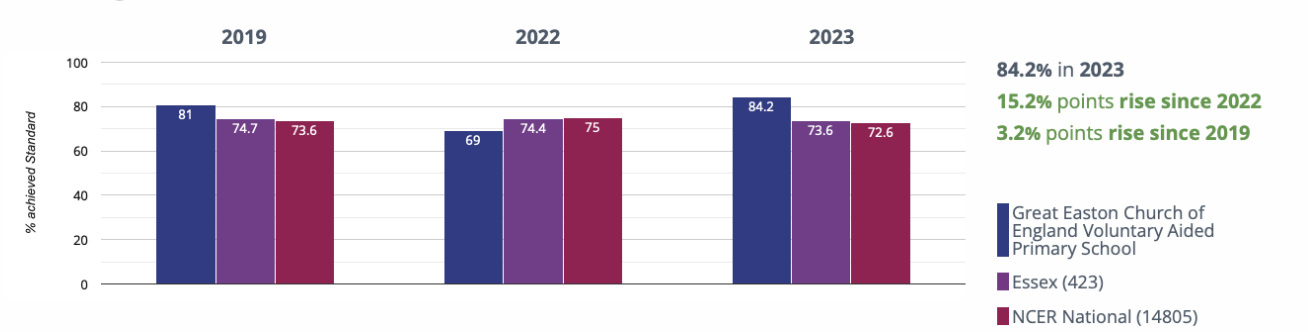
3 children have joined in KS2: 2 got at least expected in all areas and 1 was working at WTS in reading, writing, maths and GPS .

2 PPG - 1 child achieved expected in all areas and 1 child achieved 115 in reading, WTS in writing and 99 in maths.

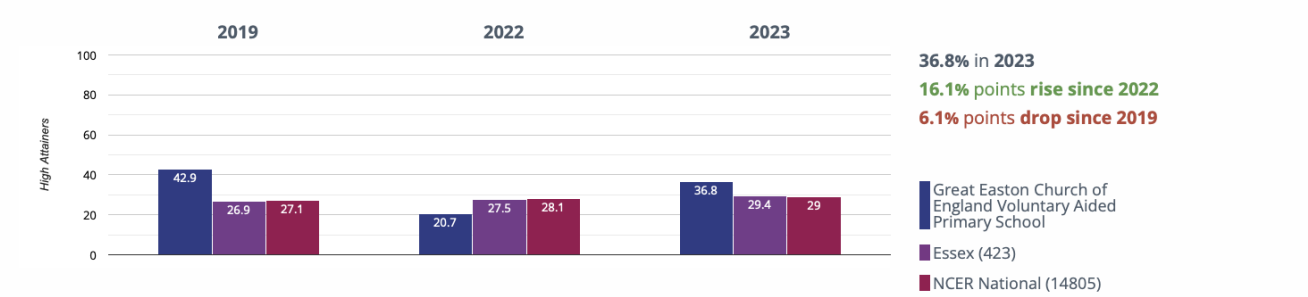
2 SEND: 1 child achieved expected in all areas and 1 child achieved 115 in reading, WTS in writing and 99 in maths.

1 child is on the vulnerable pupil register and achieved expected in reading, GPS, WTS in writing and WTS but 99 in maths.

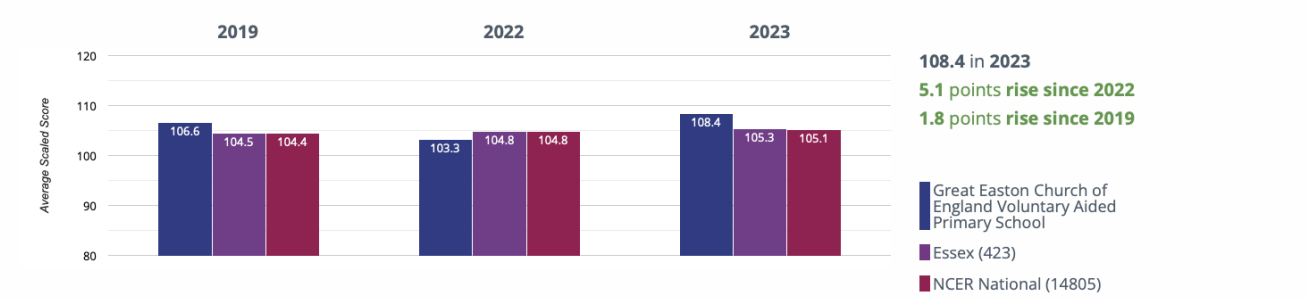

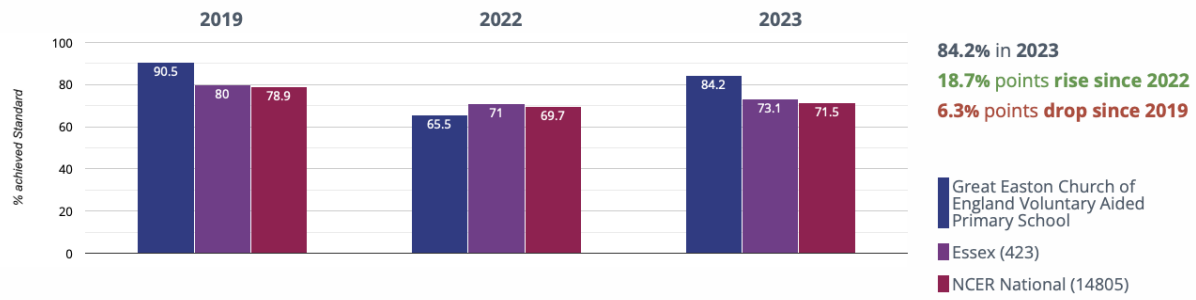
Reading - high attainers



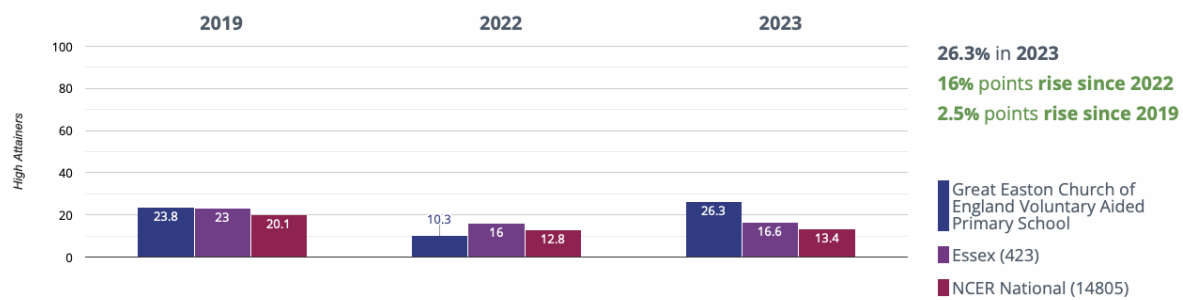
Reading - average scaled score



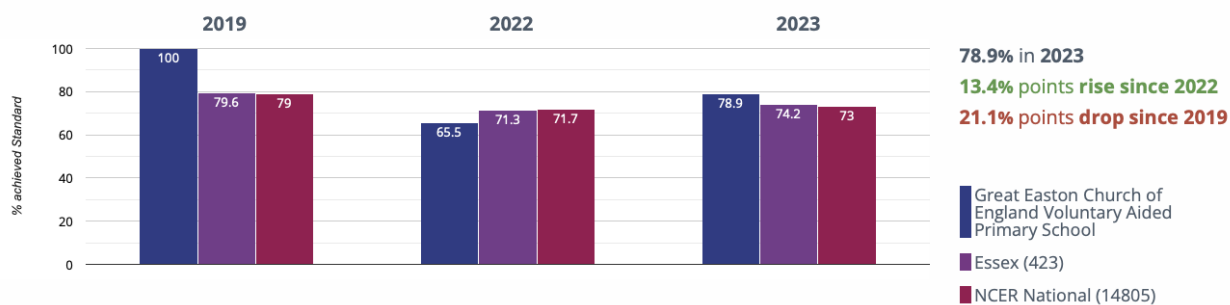
Writing - achieved standard



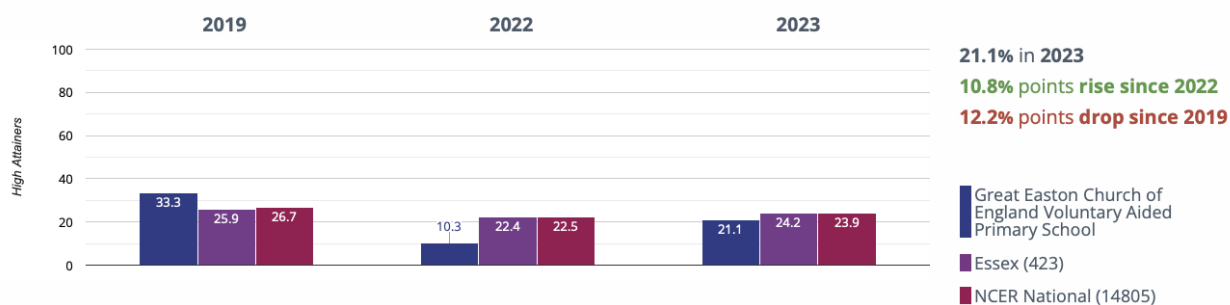
Writing - high attainers

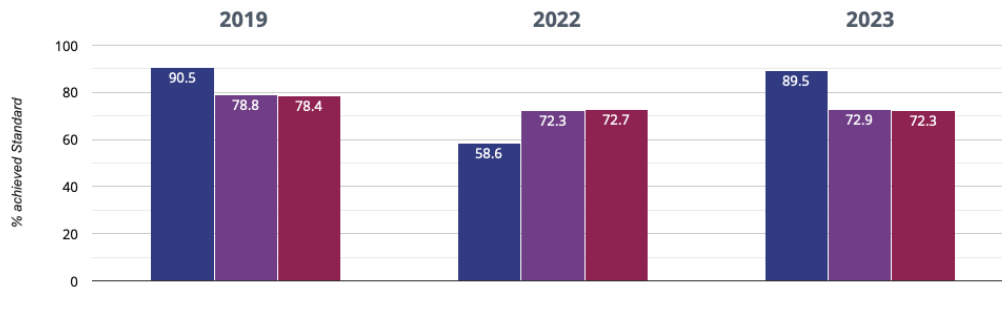

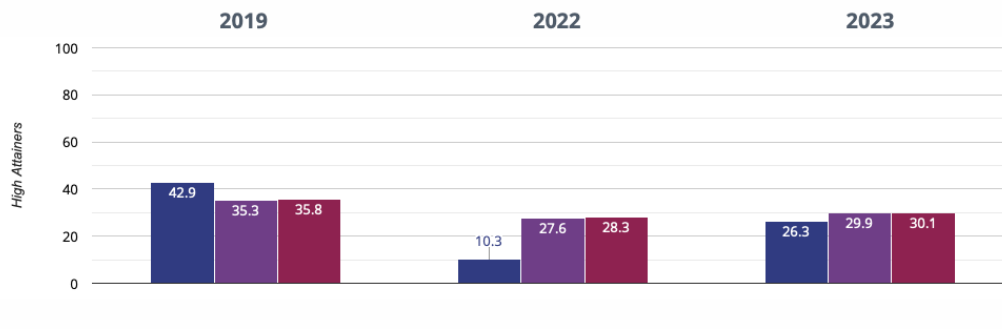

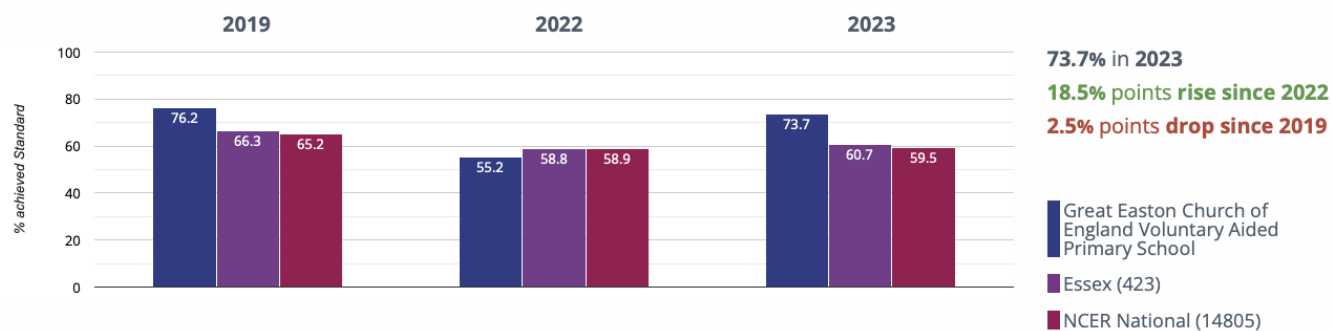
